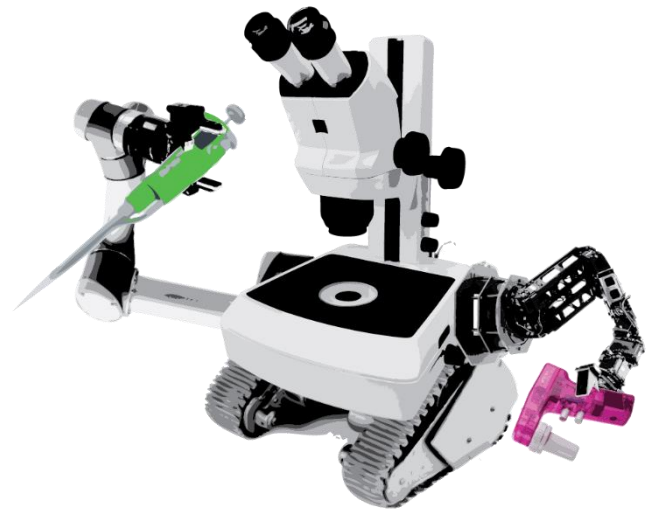

Transport
